- 3. For candidates' campaign activities and raising up of those whom God chooses. (*Psalm 89:19*)
- 4. For righteous laws to be enacted and faithfully implemented. (*Proverbs 14:34*)
- For Christians to boldly stand and speak to issues that face our nation in the 7 spheres of culture (*Ephesians 6:10*), and for Christians to fill leadership roles in each of these 7 spheres:
 Government Education Family Church
 Media Business Military

I rejoice in following your statutes as one rejoices in great riches. (Psalm 119:14) [NIV]
