Romans: 8:35, 37-39 “³⁵ Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? ³⁷ Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, ³⁹ nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Psalms 107:1-3, 6,7,9,10,14 “Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is good!* For His mercy *endures* forever.² Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy,³ And gathered out of the lands, From the east and from the west, From the north and from the south. Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, *And* He delivered them out of their distresses.⁷ And He led them forth by the right way, That they might go to a city for a dwelling place!⁹ For He satisfies the longing soul, And fills the hungry soul with goodness.¹⁰ Those who sat in darkness and in the shadow of death, Bound in affliction and irons- ¹⁴ He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, And broke their chains in pieces.”

Psalms 107:35-38 “He turns a wilderness into pools of water, and dry land into watersprings.³⁶ There He makes the hungry dwell, that they may establish a city for a dwelling place,³⁷ And sow fields and plant vineyards, blesses them, and they multiply greatly and He does not let their cattle decrease.”

Matthew 4:16 “The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in the land of the shadow of death, upon them a light has shined.”

Isaiah 10:27b “And the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.”

Isaiah 11:9b “For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea.”

Isaiah 24:14,15 “They shall lift up their voice, they shall sing, for the majesty of the Lord. They shall cry aloud from the sea. Therefore, glorify the Lord in the dawning light, the name of the Lord God of Israel in the coastlands of the sea.”

Isaiah 26:2-4 “We have a strong city, God will appoint salvation for walls and bulwarks. Open the gates, that the righteous nation which remains faithful in the truth may enter in. You will keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You. Trust in the Lord forever, for in Yah, the Lord, is everlasting strength.”

Isaiah 29:18-19 “In that day the deaf shall hear the words of the book, and the eyes of the blind shall see out of obscurity and out of darkness. The humble also shall increase their joy in the Lord, and the poor among men shall rejoice in the Holy One of Israel.”

Isaiah 30:21-23 “Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, ‘This is the way, walk in,’ it whenever you turn to the righthand or to the left. You will also defile the covering of your images of silver and the

ornament of your molded images of gold. You will throw them away as an unclean thing, you will say to them ‘Get away!’ Then He will give the rain for your seed with which you sow the ground, and bread of the increase of the earth, you will be rich and plentiful. In that day, your cattle will feed in large pastures.”

Isaiah 40:3-5 “Until the Spirit is poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness becomes a fruitful field, and the fruitful field is counted as a forest. Then Justice will dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remains in the fruitful field. The work of righteousness will be peace and the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever. My people shall dwell in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings and in quiet resting places.”

Isaiah 42:10-13 “Sing to the Lord a new song, and His praise from the ends of the earth. You who go down to the sea, and its fullness, you coastlands and you in habitants of them! Let them shout from the top of the mountains. Let them give glory to the Lord, and declare His praise in the coastlands. The Lord shall go forth like a mighty man. He shall stir up His zeal like a man of war. He shall cry out, yes, shout aloud, He shall prevail against His enemies.”

Isaiah 44:9 “Those who make an image, all of them are useless, and their precious things shall not profit.”

Isaiah 45:22-23 “Look to Me, and be saved, all you ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other. I have sworn by Myself, the word has gone out of My mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, that to Me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall take an oath.”

Isaiah 45:2-3 “I will go before you and make the crooked places straight, I will break in pieces the gates of bronze and cut the bars of iron. I will give you the treasures of darkness and hidden riches of secret places, that you may know that I, the Lord, who called you by your name, am the God of Israel.”

Isaiah 48:18b “Then your peace would have been like a river, and your righteousness like the waves of the sea.”

Isaiah 49:8-9 “Thus says the Lord: In an acceptable time I have heard you, and in the day of salvation I have helped you; I will preserve you and give you as a covenant to the people, to restore the earth, to cause them to inherit the desolate heritages; that you may say to the prisoners, ‘Go forth,’ to those who are in darkness, ‘Show yourselves.’”

Isaiah 51:5c “The coastlands will wait upon Me, and on My arm they will trust.”

Isaiah 59:19 “So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him.”

Isaiah 60:9-11, 14b, 17b-18 “Surely the coastlands shall wait for Me; the sons of foreigners shall build up your walls, and their kings shall minister to you; for in My wrath I struck you, but in My favor I have had mercy on you. Therefore, your gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day or night, that men may bring to you the wealth of the Gentiles, and their kings in procession. And they shall call you The City of the Lord; I will also make your officers peace, and your magistrates righteousness. Violence shall no longer be heard in your land, neither wasting nor destruction within your borders; but you shall call your walls salvation and your gates praise.”

Isaiah 61:1-4 “The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to preach the good tidings to the poor, He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness. And they shall rebuild the old ruins, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the ruined cities, the desolations of many generations.”

Deut. 11:9, Ez. 20:6 “⁹and that you may prolong *your* days in the land which the LORD swore to give your fathers, to them and their descendants, ‘a land flowing with milk and honey.’”

Isaiah 61:7b “Therefore in their land they shall possess double; everlasting joy shall be theirs.”

Isaiah 61:11 “For as the earth causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth, so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.”

Isaiah 45:8 “Rain down, you heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness, let the earth open, let them bring forth salvation, and let the righteousness spring up together. I, the Lord, have created it.”

Isaiah 62:10, 12 “Go through, go through the gates! Prepare the way for the people, build up, build up the highway! Take out the stones, lift up a banner for the peoples. 12 And they shall call them ‘the Holy People,’ the Redeemed of the Lord, and you shall be called Sought Out, a City Not Forsaken’.”

Isaiah 28:5,6 “In that day the Lord of hosts will be for a crown of glory and a diadem of beauty to the remnant of His people, for a spirit of justice to him who sits in justice, and for strength to those who turn back the battle at the gate.”

Psalms 68:1-2a,5,6,10 “Let God arise, let His enemies be scattered; let those who hate Him flee before Him. As smoke is driven away, so drive them away. A father of the fatherless, a defender of the widow, God sets the solitary in families, You, O God provided from Your goodness for the poor.”

Nehemiah 13:30 “Thus I cleansed them of everything pagan. I also assigned duties to the priests, and the Levites, each to his service.”

Jeremiah 29:7, 11-14 “Seek the peace of the city; and pray to the Lord for it; for in its peace you will have peace. For I know the thoughts that I have towards you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me and I will listen to you, says the Lord, and will bring you back from your captivity.

Psalms 91:9-11 “Because you have made the Lord who is my refuge, even the Most High, your dwelling place, no evil shall befall you, nor shall any plague

come near your dwelling, for He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways.”

Psalms 147:13-15 “For He has strengthened the bars of your gates, He has blessed your children within you. He makes peace within your borders, and fills you with the finest wheat. He sends out His command to the earth, His word runs very swiftly.”

Ezekiel 37:23,26 “They shall not defile themselves anymore with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions; but I will deliver them from all their dwelling places in which they have sinned, and will cleanse them. They shall be My people, and I will be their God. Moreover, I will make a covenant of peace with them, and it shall be an everlasting covenant with them. I will establish them, and I will set My sanctuary in their midst forevermore.”

Ezekiel 48:35b “...and the name of the city from that day shall be: The Lord is There.”

Acts 2:47 “...and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.”

Acts 11:21 “And the hand of the Lord was with them, and a great number believed and turned to the Lord”.

Acts 13:44 “On the next Sabbath, almost the whole city came together to hear the word of God.”

Acts 18:10 “...for I am with you, and no one will attack you to hurt you; for I have many people in this city.”

Isaiah 1:26b “Afterward you shall be called the city of righteousness, the faithful city.”

Proverbs 11:11 “By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted.”

Deuteronomy 28:3-14 “Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the country. Blessed shall be the fruit of your body, the produce of your ground and the increase of your herds, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks. The Lord will cause your enemies who rise against you to be defeated before your face, they shall come out

against you one way and flee before you seven ways. The Lord will open to you His good treasure, the heavens, to give rain to your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand. You shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow. And the Lord will make you the head and not the tail.”

Deut. 11:11, 12, 18-20 “...but the land which you cross over to possess is a land of hills and valleys, which drinks water from the rain of heaven, a land for which the Lord your God cares, the eyes of the Lord your God are always on it, from the beginning of the year to the very end of the year. Therefore, you shall lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. And you shall write them upon the doorposts of your house and on your gates.”

Romans 14:11 “As I live, says the Lord, every knee shall bow to Me, and every tongue shall confess to God.”

Eph. 2:8,9 “For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God, not of works lest any man should boast.”

Col. 1:13-17 “He has delivered us from the power of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. He is the image of the invisible God, the first born over all creation. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible,

whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.”

2 Peter 3:9 “The Lord is not slack concerning His promise – but is long suffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.”

John 3:16 “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”

Luke 10:19,20 “Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.”

Eph. 5:26, 27 “...that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.”

Ephesians 6:10-18 “Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. ¹¹ Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹² For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, ^[a] against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*. ¹³ Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, ¹⁵ and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶ above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. ¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; ¹⁸ praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints”

Titus 2:1-14 “But as for you, speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine: ² that the older men be sober, reverent, temperate, sound in faith, in love, in patience; ³ the older women likewise, that they be reverent in behavior, not slanderers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things— ⁴ that they admonish the young women to love their husbands, to love their children, ⁵ to be discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be blasphemed.⁶ Likewise, exhort the young men to be sober-minded, ⁷ in all things showing yourself to be a pattern of good works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility⁸ sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you.¹ ⁹ Exhort bondservants to be obedient to their own masters, to be well pleasing in all things, not answering back, ¹⁰ not pilfering, but showing all good fidelity, that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things.¹¹ For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, ¹² teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, ¹³ looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, ¹⁴ who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.”

Rev. 12:11 “And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.”

Numbers 35:11a, 15 “...then you shall appoint cities to be cities of refuge for you. These six cities shall be for refuge for the children of Israel, for the stranger, and for the sojourner among them...”

1 Chronicles 29:11-13 “Yours, O LORD, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; For all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O LORD, and You are exalted as head over all.¹² Both riches and honor come from You, and You reign over all. In Your hand is power and might; in Your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all.¹³ “Now therefore, our God, we thank You and praise Your glorious name.”

Habakkuk 2:14 “For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea.”
